## BOARD OF EDUCATION

Concerned with the overall problems of the organization and financing of Mineola's educational program is the Board of Education. This body of public-spirited citizens are state officials who determine the educational policies for District No. 10. The members of the Board are elected by the taxpayers of the district for terms of five years and serve without monetary compensation.

Few people stop to realize the long hours which the Board spends in meetings and consultations to plan an educational system which will function smoothly, and to organize a curriculum which will adequately equip students to cope with the problems of a rapidly changing and complex world.

This year the *Signet* is giving recognition to the fact that 1961 is the fiftieth anniversary of Mineola High School's first graduating class. It is also fitting and proper that we salute the men and women who have served on our Boards of Education since 1868. For almost a century they have unselfishly served the youth of this community with wisdom and judgment.




Mr. Herbert Levine








A mysterious player amusingly displays her ability in volleyball, one of the major girls' sports.

## TOWARD THE NEXT 50 YEARS




Above is the architect's drawing of the proposed new Mineola High School. This modern building will house the students of tomorrow, who will study the ideas and expanded knowledge of a new age.



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
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
